

Dear Parents/Guardian,

Banyule Community Health Service is sending qualified dental staff to your school for **FREE** dental check-ups on children's teeth.

If you wish for your child to have a dental check-up please complete the attached form.

After the check-up we will inform you via letter if there are any signs of decay or cavities. If needed please make a follow-up appointment with an Oral Health Therapist/Dentist. All children under the age of 13 years are eligible for free dental treatment at Banyule Community Health Dental Clinic. You can choose not to participate in the program. This will have no effect on you or your children's dental care at Banyule Community Health.

Every child that takes part in the program will be educated on how to maintain healthy teeth.

Participation in this program is voluntary. You can withdraw your child at any time. All information collected during check-up will remain confidential. This service is **FREE** for the school and parents.

- ***42% of 5 year olds & 58% of 9 year olds have dental decay in their baby teeth***
- ***Dental decay is one of the most common chronic conditions in early childhood***
- ***Dental decay is largely preventable***
