Parent Participation - Ways you can be involved

We offer many opportunities for you to contribute to the Macleod College community and we encourage as many parents as possible to become active members. You are welcome to put your hand up for any of the following:

Parents & Friends Association - This is primarily a group of enthusiastic parents who do some amazing work raising funds to enable us to purchase valuable resources to enrich the children's learning. 
