On Monday 6th August 2018, a whole school assembly was held where we welcomed a short term study group from China organised by Ace Smart Education.

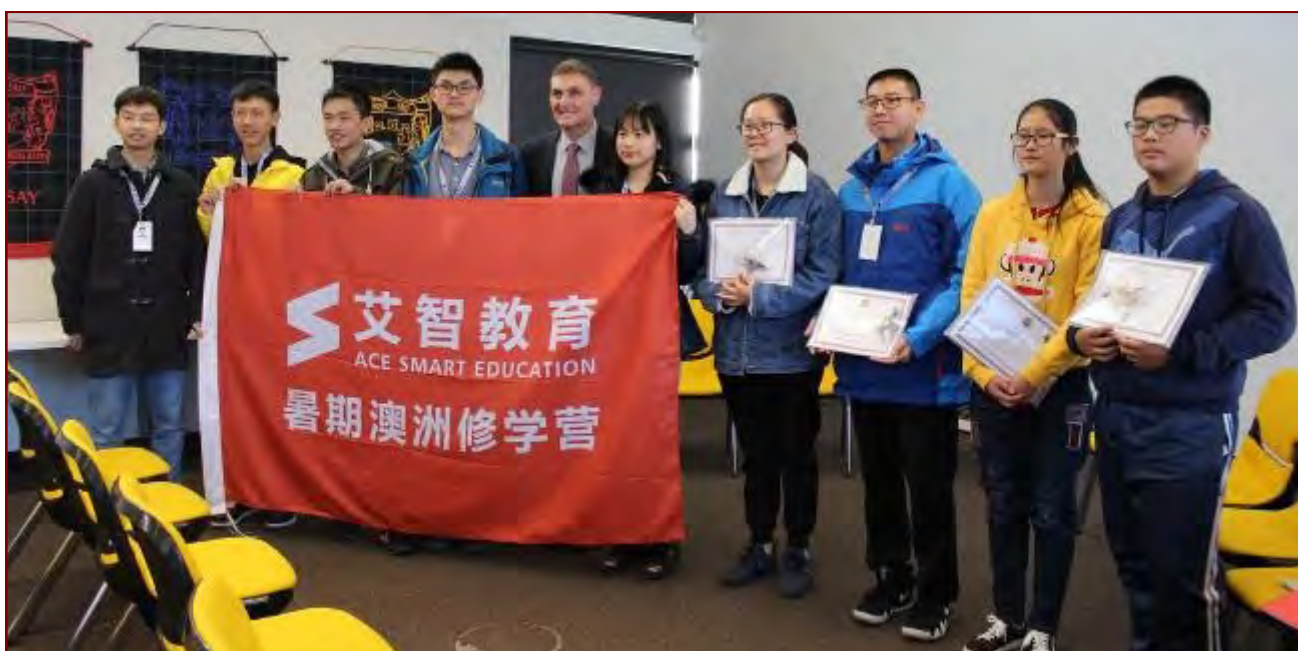
