Next year, you will be able to follow your child's progress as the year goes by, as you will be able to logon to Compass and see their learning task results in each area of the curriculum, instead of waiting until the end of each semester to see how they have progressed.

On Tuesday 19th December those families whose children have been selected for a College Award, have been sent an invitation to attend the school's annual evening at The Centre, Ivanhoe for the presentations.

The Year 12 students will also collect their completion certificates and many other awards for excellence will be given on this lovely community night. This event starts promptly at 7:30pm so please be punctual. Students who are receiving an award need to report to me by 7.15pm.

Parent Participation

We offer many opportunities for you to contribute to the Macleod College community and we encourage as many parents as possible to become active members.

Parents & Friends Association - This is primarily a group of enthusiastic parents who do some amazing work raising funds to enable us to purchase valuable resources to enrich the children's learning. They also get involved in some projects to improve our facilities as well as running Mother's and Father's Day stalls for the children to purchase gifts.

School Council - This forum gives parents an opportunity to have a voice in the decisions that are made for improving our school. It also gives you a glimpse into the inner workings of the school and hear firsthand what is happening throughout the school.

Parent Helpers - We offer a 2-hour training course which gives you skills and strategies to help children with their literacy skills in the classroom. These strategies also enable you to better support your own child with their reading and literacy tasks at home. I can highly recommend this course to you.




This week's offer

Tip of the Week - Keep Pots Cool

When the weather warms up, it's essential that you keep potted plants, especially those in terracotta pots, cool as they are vulnerable to overheating. Ways to do this include lightly mulching the pots and keeping them out of hot western sunshine. Stand them in saucers filled with sand and keep the sand moist; this will ensure the roots stay cool and the plants remain healthy.
