BYOD Program for Year 5/6 Students

As we introduced this year, our Year 5 and 6 students will be required to have their own computer for school use. Laptop information and purchase options can be accessed through the portal on the school website: http://www.macleod.vic.edu.au/ict For compatibility reasons, we also recommend that you purchase a Windows device which our college technology infrastructure can best support.

If you require assistance or advice about purchasing the best device for your child or if you have any other questions regarding the BYOD Program, please feel free to contact Simone Hale, our Head of Technology, by email via the Compass portal or phoning her at the school.

Ideally, we would like the Year 5/6 students to have a personal computer for school by the conclusion of term 1, 2018.

Headphones

I have also requested that the children bring a set of headphones to school next year. I have noticed that they are some very reasonably priced ones around at the moment. These will ensure that the children can focus on what they are doing on the computer if they require sound in games or tasks without disturbing others around them.
