All parents must register their children for the Catechist Program via the Parish Office.

The cut-off Dates for enrolment into the 2020 Sacramental Program will be:

- ✠ **Thursday 06 February 2020 for Confirmation Program**
- ✠ **Wednesday 20 May 2020 for First Eucharist Program**
- ✠ **Friday 28 August 2020 for Reconciliation Program**

The Sacramental Program involves attendance at compulsory information sessions, attendance at weekend mass and participation in Catechist Classes.

Please note that Baptism and Reconciliation (also known as Penance or Confession) is a pre-requisite for First Communion. Reconciliation and First Communion are pre-requisites for Confirmation. Children must be **Grade 3 or older to be admitted to Reconciliation; Grade 4 or older to be admitted to First Eucharist (Communion) and Grade 6 or older to be admitted to Confirmation.**
